Switch on of the Christmas tree lights followed by a firework display. There will be quiet spaces in the Library, Museum and Public Hall for anyone who needs them.

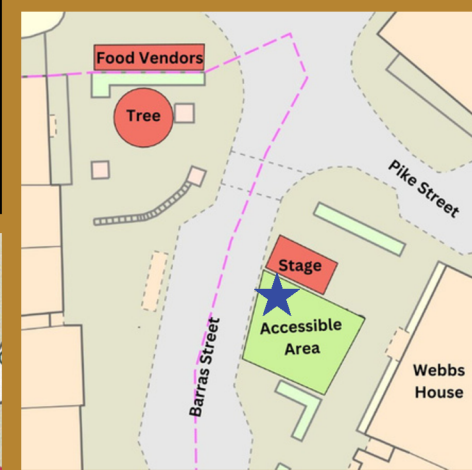
approx 6.30pm
