

**Liskeard's own Neighbourhood Development Plan** has been produced through the hard work of many volunteers in the community and responds to what local people told us about how land should be used for housing, employment, business, retail & leisure.

On Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October you will be able to VOTE on it in a Referendum - if successful the plan will come into force.

It's a detailed plan covering Liskeard's sustainable development needs up to 2030, and includes:

- \* **Priority for Jobs** new employment sites, and employment space linked to new housing.
- \* Promoting brown-field sites first before more houses can be developed on fields beyond our settlement boundary.
- \* Regenerating the town centre, including sites such as the Cattle Market making the most of what we have, & respecting the town's heritage.
- \* Improving and protecting our valuable green spaces in and around Liskeard for sport, recreation and leisure, with better walking & cycling routes, and connecting neighbourhoods
- \* **Projects** suggested by local people are also included and will enable on-going community involvement.

## Liskeard's Referendum Day VOTE on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> October

If more people vote 'yes' then Cornwall Council will have to follow the Neighbourhood Plan when making decisions over the sustainable development of Liskeard.

If the vote is 'no' then Liskeard's local Neighbourhood Plan will not be used.
